Provide a mock-up or draft of the proposed public art using the IN Indiana campaign branding.

The mural will be an adaptation of "Bandits," a painting that visual artist Greg Potter created some time ago. In the first image below, you see the sketch for the mural with the animals looking into the horizon, hopeful about the future. In the next image, you see the color palette that the artist will use on the wall. The 'Getting' Rescued In Indiana' logo will be on the left side of the mural. No references to guns or flags will appear in the mural.

<u>Improved Design</u>: Letters will be larger and the IDDC logo will be more visible because it will be closer to the canoe. Artist will paint letters in shades of pink (except the 'D') so that they stand out in the composition. Flowers will also surround letters giving more emphasis to IDDC logo.
