Re: Case C 2025-46: Rapid Prototype and Engineering

Summary:

1. On December 16, 2019, the Franklin Common Council passed Resolution No. 2019-10, approving a 5-year personal property tax abatement with a 5% economic development fee for Rapid Prototyping and Engineering located at 1424 Commerce Parkway.

2. Actual and estimated benefits, as projected for 2024:

Personal Property Improvements	\$500,000	\$685,821	\$185,821

- 3. Rapid Prototyping did not meet their estimated investment of personal property. The company is short by \$33,226. In 2022 they increased their investment and are now above by \$185,821.
- 4. The company estimated adding one new employee as a result of this investment. The company has added one new employee with wages exceeding estimates. The company has now added 7 new employees with wages above estimate. In 2022 all employees are from Rapid Prototyping and are above in numbers and wages. In 2023 wages and employees are above estimates.
- 5. The personal property tax abatement is scheduled to expire in 2025 pay 2026. The final compliance will take place in 2025.
